What is HDR Gaming Interest Group (hereafter HGIG)?

HGIG is a volunteer group of companies consisting of such industries as the gaming, display and TV, with the goal to specify and make available for the public, guidelines to improve consumer gaming experiences in HDR. HGIG is not a standardization body and does not define any standard specifications. For more detail please refer to the organization document.

How can I join HGIG?

Companies who wish to join HGIG should review the organization document and sign the organization document. For more details, please refer to Section 2 of the organization document.

Is there a logo certification program?

HGIG is not a standardization body. HGIG does not either create standard specifications, perform compliance testing, or licenses any HGIG related trademarks (including, logos). Further, HGIG does not enforce/license technologies to any parties. In essence, there is no specification / patent license program, or trademark (including, logo) certification program under HGIG. Note that “HGIG” is a registered trademark or trademark of Sony Interactive Entertainment Inc.
